Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) are an effective way to share and gain knowledge as well as make lasting changes in practice. By signing up for this PLC, you commit to eight evening sessions, and one Saturday. Between meetings, you begin to implement what you learned, fostering rich discussion and reflection within the group. Our PLC will focus on early childhood and elementary teachers who would like to, or already do, take students outside for frequent and extended play and learning experiences.
